



RULES AND REGULATIONS – CUP (S)

For U11 to U18 inclusively

S-1 QUALIFYING & GENERAL RULES

- a) Cup play will include all U11 to U18 teams that are registered with the current youth league summer season unless they have been disqualified for any breach of rules as stated in sections "A" & "C11".
- b) Team placement will be determined by a random draw by category & classification. Draw will be held on August 12th 2010.
- c) All games and discipline will be governed by League Rules.
- d) A player may play for only one team. If found on another team during the same qualifying round, that player will be automatically disqualified from the remainder of the cup series and the game for that second team having used that player shall be defaulted to the opposing team by a score of **3-0**.
- e) Reserve players may be used as long as they have played at least 2 regular season games for that same team *but a reserve player also cannot play for another team during the same qualifying round.*
- f) If a team is unable to meet the minimum requirement of 8 players &/or 1 coach 15 minutes after the scheduled start time of the game, the game shall be automatically forfeited to the opposing team by a score of **3-0**.
- g) If a team fails to appear, they will be automatically be disqualified from further cup competition.
- h) All games at the end of regulation time will proceed directly to penalty shots. All games must determine a winner.
- i) Coaches must transfer all information from his/her own game sheet onto the PTS system within 24 hours of the end of a game. Failure to do so will result in a fine of **\$10**.

S-2 FORMAT:

- a) Teams will play single elimination rounds in order to advance to the final game.
- b) All U11 to U18 games will be played within the territory covered by Lac St-Louis Youth League. Teams from ARS Outaouais will host preliminary games if they are picked as "receiver".

S-3 REFEREE ASSIGNMENT:

- ALL 11 A-SIDE PRELIMINARY GAMES WITHIN REGION: Referees to be assigned by the Regional Assignor. All referee assistants to be assigned by the category host Clubs.
- ALL 11 A-SIDE PRELIMINARY GAMES OUT OF LAC ST. LOUIS REGION: Referees and referee assistants to be assigned by the host Clubs and/or Regional Referee Assignor.
- ALL 11 A-SIDE SEMI FINALS AND FINALS WITHIN THE LAC ST. LOUIS REGION: Referees and referee assistants to be assigned by the Regional Assignor.

S-4 FINALS:

The finals are scheduled to be played on Saturday, September 18th 2010.

All finals ending in a tie will be decided as follows:

- U11 to U18 2 x 10-minute halves of added time, first team to score wins (Golden Goal)

If game is still tied after playing the added time, teams will proceed to taking kicks from the penalty mark as per F.I.F.A. regulations (both teams take five kicks).
