<b>Part 1: Before the Game</b>		
1. Did the referee arrive on time?		
2. Did the referee inspect the field and goals before the game started?		
3. Did the referee inspect the players' equipment and passports before the game started?		
<b>9 points: 3 marks for each question.</b>		

<b>Part 2: During the Game</b>		
1. Did the Referee start the game on time or within the time limits of the Region?		
2. Did the Referee start the game properly and professionally (Instructions to Assistant Referees, the ball, number of players, etc.)?		
3. In general, was the Referee sufficiently fit to follow the play in order to make proper calls?		
4. In general, was the Referee sufficiently fit to adopt adequate field positions both during play and during stoppages?		
5. In general, did the physical fitness of the Referee allow a proper use of the diagonal system?		
6. In general, did the physical fitness of the Referee allow sprinting when necessary?		
7. the field, did the Referee communicate reasonable well with the Assistant Referees?		
8. In general, were the hand signals clear?		
9. In general, did the Referee whistle reasonably loud and with appropriate tones of gravity?		
10. Did the Referee maintain player safety?		
11. In general, were direct and indirect fouls called in accordance with the rules of the game?		
12. Was the advantage rule applied reasonably well?		
13. In general, did the Referee make a distinction between intentional and non-intentional fouls?		
14. Did the Referee implement the rules of the games fairly and with impartiality?		
15. Were yellow and red cards used appropriately and in accordance with the rules of the game?		
16. Were cautions and expulsions administered properly and professionally? For example, did the ejected player(s) leave the field of play?		
17. Considering the presence or absence of Assistant Referees, were the offsides called reasonably well?		
18. In general, did the Referee make calls consistently throughout the game?		
19. In general, did the Referee maintain a reasonable control of the game?		
<b>76 points: 4 marks for each question.</b>		
<b>Note:</b> The expression "in general" is used quite often in order to be reminded that a Referee has some flexibility on the field.		

<b>Part 3: After the Game</b>		
1. Was the Referee properly uniformed and did he/she demonstrate a professional appearance?		
2. Was the Referee respectful toward players, coaches and spectators; or, was he/she provocative?		
3. Did the Referee demonstrate self-confidence and courage on the field?		
4. In general, did the Referee obtain the respect of players and coaches?		
5. Did the referee fulfill adequately the end-of-game tasks?		
<b>15 points: 3 marks for each question.</b>		

**Note:** If the answer to any of the questions in the **3 parts** above is yes, then the referee should be given full marks. The approach should be pass or fail: a high mark for pass and a low mark for fail.

<b>Part 4: Pertinent Information</b>
1. Did the local club provide Assistant Referees?
2. Were the Assistant Referees reasonably competent?
3. Degree of difficulty of the game: easy _____; difficult _____; very difficult _____.
4. Was the field properly lined to assist the Referee?

<b>Part 5: Additional Comments</b>
Additional comments must be kept at a minimum and must deal with exceptional circumstances. Also, they must deal with specific facts and not with personal opinions.
