1. Did the referee arrive on time (approximately 30 minutes before the start of the game)?		
2. Did the referee inspect the field and goal nets?		
3. Did the referee inspect and collect the passports?		
4. Did the referee inspect the players' equipment properly?		
5. Did the referee inspect the ball?		
10 points: 2 marks for each question.		

Part 2: During the Game		
1. Did the Referee start the game on time or within the time limits of the Region?		
2. Did the Referee start the game properly?		
3. Did the Referee follow the play in order to make proper calls?		
4. Did the Referee adopt adequate field positions both during play and during stoppages?		
5. In general, were the hand signals clear?		
6. In general, did the Referee whistle reasonably loud?		
7. Did the Referee deal with the safety of players adequately?		
8. In general, did the Referee assure that proper distances were respected?		
9. In general, were minor fouls within the penalty area administered properly?		
10. Was the advantage rule applied reasonably well?		
11. Did the Referee administer throw-ins properly?		
12. Did the Referee administer the "pass-back" rule properly?		
13. In general, did the Referee make a distinction between intentional and non-intentional fouls?		
14. Did the Referee implement the rules of the game reasonably fair?		
15. Were yellow and red cards used appropriately and in accordance with the rules of the game?		
16. Were cautions and expulsions administered properly and professionally? For example, did the ejected player(s) leave the field of play?		
17. In general, were substitutions administered properly?		
18. In general, did the Referee deal with injuries properly?		
19. Did the Referee make calls consistently throughout the game?		
20. Did the Referee maintain a reasonable control of the game?		
80 points: 4 marks for each question.		
Note: The expression "in general" is used quite often in order to be reminded that a Referee has some flexibility on the field.		

Part 3: The Referee		
1. Was the Referee properly uniformed and did he/she demonstrate a professional appearance?		
2. Was the Referee respectful toward players, coaches and spectators; or, was he/she provocative?		
3. Did the Referee demonstrate self-confidence and courage on the field?		
4. In general, did the Referee obtain the respect of players and coaches?		
5. Did the referee fulfill adequately the end-of-game tasks?		
10 points: 2 marks for each question.		

Note: If the answer to any of the questions in the **3 parts** above is yes, then the referee should be given full marks. The approach should be pass or fail: a high mark for pass and a low mark for fail.
