YOUTH & METRO INDOOR LEAGUE 2008-2009 FOURTH (4th) OFFICIALS DUTIES

1. The fourth (4th) Official must fulfill the following:

- Be affiliated for the current season of competition
- Must be in "good standing" with the Regional Referee Committee

2. The fourth (4th) Official, must adhere to the following:

- Arrives thirty (30) minutes prior to the first scheduled game
- Is dressed in appropriate referee attire
- Possesses the necessary equipment to referee a soccer game
- Possesses a print out of the daily scheduled matches
- Respects and fulfills the duties assigned to him/her as a regional referee
- Respects and fulfills FIFA Laws of the game - Law 6 (THE ASSISTANT REFEREES)

3. The fourth (4th) Official Must:

- Sets up the table provided at the North end of the complex (Headquarters)
- Remains within the competition venue and in the vicinity of the playing area
- Is responsible for inspecting the passports for all players & coaches on game sheets for games scheduled on his/her shift
- Ensures that the game sheet is properly completed. If not, he/she returns it to the coach for proper completion
- Is responsible for the execution of Law 4 (THE PLAYERS EQUIPEMENT)
- Signs his/her name in the "Assistant Referee" portion of the game sheet
- Collect 2 game balls from the Home team and check they are in accordance to Law 2 (THE BALL)
- Delivers the inspected game sheets and passports & game balls to the assigned referee
- Replaces an absent or injured referee under the following conditions:
 - a) The 4th official first notifies the other officials of his absence
 - b) The teams are now themselves responsible for verification (YL rules)
- Provides assistance, wherever needed, to assigned officials.
- Reports to the **Competition Coordinator** and the **Referee Coordinator** any **Major Incident** that he/she has witnessed or has become involved in.

Failure to comply with the above-mentioned procedures may result in revocation of assignments, written reprimand, or in extreme cases – disciplinary sanction by the RRC or Regional Discipline Committee.
