## YOUTH & METRO INDOOR LEAGUE 2008-2009 REFEREES RESPONSIBILITES

**1. The Referee must fulfill the following:**

- Be affiliated for the current season of competition
- Must be in "good standing" with the Regional Referee Committee

**2. The Referee, assigned must adhere to the following:**

- Arrive thirty (30) minutes prior to the first scheduled game
- Is dressed in appropriate referee attire
- Possesses the necessary equipment to referee a soccer game
- Possesses a print out or facsimile of his/her assigned matches
- Respects and fulfills the duties assigned to him/her as a regional referee
- Respects and fulfills the duties assigned to him/her as per Law 5 (THE REFEREE)

**3. The fourth (4th) Official must:**

- Prepares for his/her assigned game(s)
- Remains within the competition venue and in the vicinity of the playing area
- Is responsible for the application of the FIFA Laws of the Game
- Is responsible for the application of the specific rules of competition
- Signs his/her name in the "Referee" portion of the game sheet
- Remits the completed game sheets (white copy) to the regional office by sliding them under the door (SUITE 201) of the regional office on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor
- Completes and sends within 48 hours, a properly written discipline report for any expulsion, to the regional office by mail, fax or delivery
- Reports to the **Competition Coordinator** and the **Referee Coordinator** any **Major Incident** that he/she has witnessed or has become involved in.

Failure to comply with the above-mentioned procedures may result in revocation of assignments, written reprimand, or in extreme cases – disciplinary sanction by the RRC or Regional Discipline Committee.
