



RULES AND REGULATIONS – CUP (S)

(COMPETITIVE - REV. 2007-12-01)



For U10 to U18 inclusively

S-1 GENERAL RULES:

- a) All games and discipline will be governed by League Rules.
- b) The first named team is the home team.
- c) Cup play will include all U10 to U18 teams that are registered with the current youth league summer season unless they have been disqualified for any breach of rules as stated in sections "A", "C7" & "C11".
- d) A player may play for only one team. If found on another team, that player will be automatically disqualified from the remainder of the cup series. The game for that second team having used that player shall be defaulted to the opposing team by a score of **3-0**.

S-2 FORMAT:

- a) Teams will play single elimination rounds in order to advance to the final game:

- b) All U10 to U18 games will be played within the territory covered by Lac St-Louis Youth League. Teams from ARS Outaouais will host preliminary games if they are higher ranked in their bracket.
- c) Referee Assignment
 - i ALL 7 A-SIDE PRELIMINARY GAMES: Referees to be assigned by the Clubs.
 - ii ALL 11 A-SIDE PRELIMINARY GAMES WITHIN REGION: Referees to be assigned by the Regional Assignor. All linesmen to be assigned by the Clubs.
 - iii ALL 11 A-SIDE PRELIMINARY GAMES OUT OF LAC ST. LOUIS REGION: Referees and linesmen to be assigned by the Clubs and/or Regional Referee Assignor.
 - iv ALL 7 A-SIDE AND 11 A-SIDE SEMI FINALS AND FINALS WITHIN THE LAC ST. LOUIS REGION: Referees and linesmen to be assigned by the Regional Assignor.

S-3 QUALIFYING:

- a) Team placement will be determined by the official final season standings.

- b) All games EXCEPT FINAL tied at the end of regulation time will proceed directly to shootouts. All games must determine a winner.
- c) If a team is unable to meet the minimum players 5 or 8 (eight) &/or coaches 1 (one) requirements 15 (fifteen) minutes after the scheduled start time of the game, the game shall be forfeited to the opposing team by a score of **3-0**.
- d) If a team fails to appear, they will be automatically be disqualified from further cup competition.
- e) Coaches must transfer all information from his/her own game sheet onto the PTS system within 24 (twenty four) hours of the end of a game. Failure to do so will result in a fine of **\$10**.

S-4 FINALS:

The finals are scheduled to be played on Saturday, September 20th with Sunday, September 21st being the alternate date.

All finals ending in a tie will be decided as follows:

- U102 x 5 minutes overtime periods to be played in full.
- U11 to U18 2 x 10 minutes overtime periods to be played in full.

If game is still tied following two overtime periods, teams will proceed to penalty kicks as per F.I.F.A. regulations (both teams take five kicks).
